

**Great American Video Contest
AMMENDED OFFICIAL RULES**

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

1. **PROMOTION PERIOD:** Great American Video Contest (the “Contest”) begins at 12:00:01am Eastern Time (“ET”) on June 16, 2010 and ends at 11:59:59pm ET on August 5, 2010 (the “Promotion Period”). During the Promotion Period, there will be three (3) segments as set forth below. The Sponsor’s computer is the official time keeping device for this Contest.

2. **ELIGIBILITY:** The Contest is open to legal residents of the forty-eight (48) contiguous United States and District of Columbia who are at least sixteen (16) years of age or older as of the date of entry. Subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. Void in Alaska, Hawaii, and where prohibited or restricted by law. Individuals who have won a prize from the Radio Show within one hundred eighty (180) days prior to the start date of this Contest are not eligible.

Employees of Premiere Radio Networks, Inc. (the “Sponsor”), The Sean Hannity Show (the “Radio Show”), Westbury Jeep Chrysler Dodge (the “Vehicle Provider”), Freedom Alliance, Premiere Speakers Bureau (collectively, the “Contest Entities”), each radio station contracted to broadcast the Radio Show, and their respective subsidiaries and affiliated companies, divisions, parent companies, officers, directors, agents and advertising agencies, as well as members of the immediate family of any such employees, are not eligible to participate and win. The term “immediate family” includes spouses, siblings, parents, children, grandparents, and grandchildren, whether as “in-laws,” or by current or past marriage(s), remarriage(s), adoption, co-habitation or other family extension, and any other persons residing at the same household whether or not related.

3. **HOW TO ENTER:** During the Submission Period, visit <http://www.hannity.com> and follow the Contest link to complete all required information in the online entry form. Then, upload an original video created by you honoring and saluting the United States military (the “Theme”). All entries will become property of the Sponsor and will not be returned.

Only one (1) video entry per participant and any prize awarded in the Contest will only be made to the Contest participant. Multiple participants are not allowed to use the same email address. Any attempt by a participant to acquire more than one (1) entry by using numerous email addresses, registrations, identities, or any other methods will void that participant’s entries and that participant may be disqualified. The use of automated software or computer programs to register, enter, and/or vote in the Contest is prohibited, and any individual who uses or attempts to use such methods to register, enter, and/or vote will be disqualified. Valid entries must contain all information requested. Incomplete and/or multiple entries will be disqualified. In the event of a dispute, the authorized account holder of the email address used to enter will be deemed to be the participant. The authorized account holder is the natural person who is assigned an email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider, or other organization responsible for assigning email addresses. Contest winner(s) will be selected from online entries only. One (1) prize per household. The Sponsor will not verify receipt of entries. By entering, participants acknowledge compliance with the Official Rules, including eligibility requirements. Responsibility for receipt of entry rests solely with the participant.

Participant must to be the owner of the material submitted. No licensed materials accepted. Participants who enter the Contest with a video which contains other actors/participants must obtain a consent and release from each actor/participant. All entries must be received during the Submission Period to be eligible for consideration. All entries become the property of the Sponsor and will not be returned. Videos can only be entered once into the Contest and by one (1) individual.

4. **ENTRY CRITERIA:**

- Video entry honoring and saluting the United States military.
- Video entry should be no longer than one (1) minute in length.
- Video entry should not exceed one hundred (100) MB in size.
- Permitted formats of the video are 3gpp, asf, asx, avi, flv, mov, mp4, mpg, or wmv.

5. **ENTRY GUIDELINES:**

- Must be FCC acceptable, including no use of indecent or obscene material or language.
- Content should not infringe or violate any copyright, patent, trademark, trade secret, right of publicity, or other intellectual property, proprietary, or contractual right of a third party.

- No defamatory or libelous material or material which discloses private or personal matters concerning any person, without such person's consent.
- No content or material that is illegal, contains nudity or is sexually explicit, or by law, obscene, profane or pornographic.
- No content which implies or portrays crime or graphic violence.
- No content which is abusive or harassing towards any individual or group of individuals regarding race, sex, religion, creed, national origin, age, disability, gender identity or expression, sexual orientation, or any legally protected classification. Specifically this includes, but is not limited to, epithets or slurs (such as the "N" word), threats, intimidations, or hostile acts.

The Sponsor reserves the right to reject any entry, in its sole discretion, based on current broadcast standards and other programming and operating practices and policies established by the Sponsor for airing advertising.

- 6. WARRANTY:** By submitting a video entry you warrant and represent that the video entry is an original work, created solely by you, and it does not infringe on any third party's intellectual property rights, including copyrights, trademarks or other proprietary or personal rights. You warrant and represent that the video entry does not contain defamatory, inaccurate, abusive, obscene, profane, sexually oriented, or threatening material. The video entry shall be free and clear of any claims by any person whose performances or depictions are embodied in the work, or any person rendering services in connection with the work. The video entry shall not contain any materials owned or controlled by a third party for which you have not obtained a license, such as samples, clips, "mashups", "remixes" or the like. **The Sponsor reserves the right to remove any video entry that it deems to be in violation of these Official Rules.**
- 7. CONDITIONS ON PARTICIPATION:** By participating, you agree (a) to be bound by these Official Rules; (b) as between you and Contest Sponsor, that the decisions of the Sponsor is final on all matters relating to the Contest; (c) you are not participating on behalf of any employer or third party; and (d) if you are a party to any third party agreement with a production company, publishing company or any other third party, such agreement does interfere with your participation in this Contest and/or receipt of any of the prizes listed herein, nor will you and will not enter into an agreement with any entity that would grant or transfer any rights of your entry or any existing or yet to be created, musical recordings, phonorecords or original musical compositions written or recorded by you.
- 8. OWNERSHIP IN VIDEO AND LICENSES GRANTED: You retain all ownership rights that you have in your video entry if you have created your video entry yourself.** However, by submitting the video entry to us, you hereby grant to us a worldwide, non-exclusive, non-restrictive, royalty-free, sublicenseable and transferable license to use, reproduce, distribute, transmit, make available, prepare derivative works of, display, and perform the video entry (including any title of the video entry and your name and likeness) in connection with the Sponsor, Radio Show, and the Contest (and all places where some or all content from the Radio Show's website is available) and otherwise in connection with the Sponsor's businesses, including without limitation for promoting and redistributing part or all of the Sponsor, Radio Show, either of its websites, or iheartradio.com (and derivative works thereof) in any media formats and through any media channels. You also hereby grant each user of the Radio Show's website a non-exclusive license to access the video entry. If you do not want the Sponsor to share your video entry or obtain any rights in your video entry, please do not participate in the Contest.
- 9. JUDGING/VIEWING DETAILS:**
Judging Period: During the Judging Period, a panel of judges provided by the Radio Show will select four (4) finalists (the "Finalist(s)") from all eligible video entries received based on the following criteria (the "Judging Criteria"):
 - Originality;
 - Creativity;
 - Sincerity;
 - Use of the Theme.

Each of the four (4) Judging Criteria items can earn a maximum of twenty-five (25) points for a total maximum of one hundred (100) points. All decisions of the judges are final. Sponsor reserves the right to select less than four (4) Finalists, if, in its sole discretion, it does not receive a sufficient number of eligible video entries.

Public Voting Period: During the Public Voting Period, each Finalist's video entry will be posted at the Radio Show's website for people to vote. If an entry receives multiple and/or irregular views or multiple views from the same user or users, including but not limited to, votes generated by a robotic, programmed, script, macro, other automated means or other source, the Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify the Finalist in its sole discretion.

By participating in the voting portion of this Contest, each viewing participant agrees to be bound by these Official Rules.

- 10. WINNER SELECTION:** The Finalist video entry that receives the most votes during the Public Voting Period will be deemed the Grand Prize winner. In the event of a tie during either the Judging Period or Public Voting Period, an additional, qualified, "tie-breaking" judge shall determine the winner from such tied entries using the Judging Criteria herein. All decisions of the

judges will be final. Winners agree to be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsor, whose decisions are final on all matters relating to this Contest.

11. **PRIZE(S):** ONE (1) GRAND PRIZE; (a) A 2011 Jeep Grand Cherokee "Freedom Edition" 4X4 (the "Vehicle") (Approximate Retail Value ("ARV"): \$32,995.00), (b) The opportunity for the winner's video to be shown live at up to eight (8) *Freedom Concerts 2010*, (c) A trip for two (2) people to attend one (1) *Freedom Concerts 2010* (the "Concert") at a venue nearest the winner's hometown (as determined by Radio Show) (ARV: \$3,000.00), and (d) A Runner-Up prize pack (ARV: \$105.00). The trip includes round trip coach airfare for two (2) people from the major airport nearest the winner's home to the major airport nearest the Concert location (as determined by Radio Show), two (2) nights standard hotel accommodations (single room/double occupancy), two (2) tickets to the Concert, a meet and greet with Sean Hannity at the Concert (the "Visit"), and airport transfers. THREE (3) RUNNER-UP PRIZES; One (1) limited edition autographed and numbered hardcopy of Sean Hannity's book "Conservative Victory" (ARV: \$30.00) and a gift basket of Sean Hannity merchandise and accessories (ARV: \$75.00). The total ARV of all prizes is \$36,415.00.

Grand Prize travel must take place by August 27, 2010 and is subject to Concert schedule and availability. If the Grand Prize winner is unavailable for travel on the designated date, the Grand Prize winner will forfeit his/her rights to travel portion of the prize, no cash substitution shall be offered, and the Sponsor and Radio Show shall have no further responsibility for that portion of the prize. Grand Prize winner and guest must travel out of the same airport and on the same itinerary. A minor must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Certain travel restrictions and blackout dates may apply. Meals, incidentals, gratuities, phone calls, luggage fees, travel insurance and any and all other expenses not specifically mentioned herein are the sole responsibility of the Grand Prize winner and each Runner-Up winner, as applicable. Radio Show, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to provide ground transportation in lieu of air transportation if Grand Prize winner resides within one hundred twenty-five (125) miles from the prize destination. If, for any reason, the Concert and/or the Visit are postponed or canceled, the Sponsor and Radio Show shall have no further responsibility for that portion of the prize and the prize will be awarded without the Concert and/or the Visit on the same itinerary. The Grand Prize winner will be solely responsible for all title, license, and registration fees, freight, additional equipment, all federal, state, and local taxes, insurance, gasoline, vehicle maintenance, any delivery costs exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), and all other fees and expenses associated with the receipt and use of the Vehicle. The exterior and interior color of the Vehicle will be designated by the Vehicle Provider. All additional Vehicle options will be the sole responsibility of the Grand Prize winner. The Grand Prize winner must provide proof of valid automobile liability insurance and a valid driver's license prior to taking delivery of the Vehicle and he/she must take delivery within sixty (60) days of the Concert date. The Sponsor and Radio Show reserve the right to substitute any portion of these prizes, including destination and travel dates, for a prize of equal or greater value. No transfer, assignment, change of the prize, or cash substitution is permitted except at the sole discretion of the Sponsor. If a winner cannot be contacted or is disqualified, the Sponsor reserves the right to determine an alternate winner in its sole discretion. Unclaimed prize(s) will not be awarded. Other restrictions may apply. All federal, state, and local taxes on the prize are the sole responsibility of each winner.

12. **RELEASE FORMS:** Winner(s) will be notified by telephone, mail, and/or email on or about July 30, 2010 and will be given five (5) days to confirm receipt of notification. Sponsor is not responsible for any change of email address, mailing address, and/or telephone number of participants. If a winner cannot be contacted from the information provided on the online entry form, the Sponsor reserves the right to select another winner at its sole discretion and if time permits. Winner(s) (or his/her parent or legal guardian if a winner is deemed a minor in his/her state of residence) will be required to complete and return an Affidavit of Eligibility/Liability Release (including, unless prohibited by law, a Publicity Release) (the "Affidavit") within five (5) days of notification. Failure to return the executed Affidavit within that time may result in forfeiture of prize and selection of alternate winner from remaining eligible entries. A parent or legal guardian of any participant who is a minor must sign a release on behalf of the minor for the minor to be eligible to receive a prize. A prize won by a minor may be awarded to the minor's parent or legal guardian in the Sponsor's sole discretion. Guest of the Grand Prize winner (or his/her parent or legal guardian if a guest is deemed a minor in his/her state of residence) must complete a Liability Release (including, unless prohibited by law, a Publicity Release) prior to issuance of travel documents. Winner(s) will be subject to a verification process, to include winner's name, address, home phone number, work/cell phone number, and social security number or taxpayer identification number. The Sponsor is not liable if email is not responded to within the time allowed or prize notification letter is lost in the mail or returned as undeliverable when delivery is attempted by regular mail.
13. **VOTING CONTESTS:** By participating in the voting portion of any contest, each voting participant agrees to be bound by these Official Rules. Voting is limited to one (1) vote per participant or IP address per day during the Voting Period. If a participant receives multiple and/or irregular votes or multiple votes from the same user or users, including but not limited to, votes generated by a robotic, programmed, script, macro, other automated means or other source, the Sponsor reserve the right to disqualify the participant in its sole discretion. If the contest includes the use of an internet tool and the internet voting process fails to operate properly or appears to be tampered with or tainted with errors, fraud or unfair practices, the Sponsor reserves the right to use another means to determine the winner(s), i.e. random selection or appointing a panel of judges. All decisions of the judges are final and binding.
14. **DELIVERY DISCLAIMER:** The Sponsor disclaims all liability for the inability of a participant to complete an online entry due

to equipment malfunction, busy lines, inadvertent disconnections, acts beyond their control, or otherwise. The Sponsor disclaims all liability for any delays, misdelivery, loss, or failure in the delivery of any item sent by electronic transmission or other delivery method. The Sponsor is not responsible for human, mechanical, technical, electronic, communications, telephone, computer, hardware or software errors, malfunctions or failures of any kind, including: any form of active or passive filtering, insufficient space in participant's e-mail account to receive e-mail messages, failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed transmission of online entries, traffic congestion on telephone lines, the Internet, or on any website, or lost or unavailable network connections which may limit an online participant's ability to participate in the Contest, and any injury or damage to participant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participating in or downloading any information necessary to participate in the Contest. No mechanically reproduced entries or facsimiles will be accepted. Entries void if incomplete, defective, altered, forged, illegible, or received outside authorized channels. Sponsor reserves the right at its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual (and all of his or her entries, or any portion thereof) who tampers with the entry process. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion to cancel or suspend this Contest should fraud, virus, bugs or other causes beyond the control of Sponsor corrupt the administration, security or proper play of the Contest. In the event of cancellation, Sponsor will determine winners in an equitable manner as determined by Sponsor.

15. **PUBLICITY; USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION:** By participating, unless prohibited by law, all participants and winner(s) grant the Sponsor permission to use their names, biographical information, characters, photographs, voices, videotape, and/or likenesses in connection with promotion of this and other contests in any and all media now known or hereinafter invented without territorial or time limitations and waive any claims to compensation, royalty, right, or remuneration for such use. By participating in the Contest, unless prohibited by law, participants agree that the Sponsor may disclose personal information obtained from participants in the Contest to third parties and use such information for marketing and other purposes. Additionally, you agree to grant to the Sponsor all rights to use any video entry that you submit, and the image, likeness, voice, name and photographs in the video entry or otherwise submitted or provided by you in any publicity or advertising relating to the video entry or the Sponsor and the Contest, without compensation or approval (except where prohibited by law).
16. **CONSUMER CREATED CONTENT:** By submitting an entry in the Contest, you hereby warrant and represent that your entry conforms to the entry requirements set forth herein. By submitting an entry: (1) you agree that your disclosure is gratuitous, unsolicited and without restriction and will not place the Sponsor or Contest Entities under any fiduciary or other obligation, that the Sponsor is free to disclose the ideas on a non-confidential basis to anyone or otherwise use the ideas without any additional compensation to you; (2) you acknowledge that, by acceptance of your submission, the Sponsor and Contest Entities do not waive any rights to use similar or related ideas previously known to Sponsor, or developed by their employees, or obtained from sources other than you; (3) you are verifying that you are the owner and producer of the submitted material and that no third party ownership rights exist to any material submitted, (4) you are hereby granting the Sponsor and Contest Entities a perpetual, worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty-free, sub-licensable (through multiple tiers) right and license to use, publish, reproduce, display, perform, adapt, modify, distribute, have distributed and promote such entry content in any form, in all media now known or hereinafter created, anywhere in the world, for any purpose, and (5) you warrant and represent that the entry is your original work, has not been previously published, does not violate any third party rights, including but not limited to copyright, trademark, rights of publicity or other intellectual property and that the publication of your entry by Sponsor will not infringe on the rights of any third party rights. **ENTRIES POSTED TO THE WEBSITE WERE NOT EDITED BY SPONSOR AND ARE THE VIEWS/OPINIONS OF THE INDIVIDUAL PARTICIPANT AND DO NOT REFLECT THE VIEWS OF SPONSOR IN ANY MANNER.** Any waiver of any obligation hereunder by Sponsor does not constitute a general waiver of any obligation to participants. Sponsor reserves the right to waive the Contest entry requirements set forth herein in its reasonable discretion. Sponsor reserves the right, in its reasonable discretion, during or upon completion of the Promotion Period, to request that any participant resubmit his or her entry which fails to comply with the Contest entry requirements prior to any judging or voting period. Sponsor reserves the right to, and may or may not, monitor/screen entries prior to posting them to the Radio Show's website. By accepting a prize, the winner(s) agree that his/her entry will be deemed a Work Made For Hire under the Copyright laws of the United States, but if it cannot be so deemed, then the winner(s) irrevocably assign and transfer to Sponsor all of his/her right, title and interest in and to his/her video, including all but not limited to all copyright and trademark rights which he or she may have, in the United States and worldwide, therein, for consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged. Winner(s) hereby waive in favor of Sponsor, all rights of "Droit Moral" or "Moral Rights of Authors" or any similar rights or principles of law that winner(s) may now or later have to their entry. Sponsor reserves the right to alter, change or modify the winning entry, in its sole discretion. Upon request of Sponsor, winner(s) shall execute and deliver such additional instrument of assignment, as may be solely deemed by Sponsor, reasonably necessary to establish the ownership of record of the right, title and interest in and to the entry and of the copyrights transferred and "Moral Rights of Authors" waived under these Official Rules. Should Sponsor fail to request the said assignment as stated, that shall not be deemed a waiver of Sponsor's rights and Sponsor may at a later time request the assignment.
17. **TAXES:** Any valuation of the prize stated above is based on available information provided to the Sponsor, and the value of any prize awarded to a winner will be reported for tax purposes as required by law. Winner(s) are solely responsible for reporting and paying any and all applicable taxes related to the prize and paying any expenses associated with any prize(s) which are not specifically provided for in the Official Rules. Persons who violate any rule, gain unfair advantage in participating in the Contest, or obtain winner status using fraudulent means will be disqualified. The Sponsor will interpret these rules and resolve any disputes, conflicting claims or ambiguities concerning the rules or the Contest and the Sponsor's decisions concerning such disputes shall be final. If the conduct or outcome of the Contest is affected by human error, any mechanical malfunctions or failures of any kind, intentional interference or any event beyond the control of the Sponsor, the Sponsor reserves the right to terminate this Contest, or make such other decisions regarding the outcome as the Sponsor deems appropriate. All decisions will be made by the Sponsor and are final. The Sponsor may waive any of these rules in its sole discretion. Any attempt by a participant or any other individual to deliberately circumvent, disrupt, damage or undermine the legitimate operation of this Contest is a violation of criminal and civil laws. Should such an attempt be made, the Sponsor reserves the right to seek civil and/or criminal prosecution and/or damages from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law.
19. **RELEASE AND INDEMNITY:** As a condition of entering, participants (or their parent/legal guardian if an eligible minor) agree (and agree to confirm in writing): (a) to release the Contest Entities, each radio station contracted to broadcast the Radio Show, and their respective subsidiaries and affiliated companies, divisions, parent companies, officers, directors, employees, agents and employees of agents, and advertising and public relations agencies and all others associated with the development and execution of the Contest, from and against any and all liability with respect to or in any way arising from this Contest or the use of the participant's entry and the awarding, receipt, possession and/or use or misuse of any prize, including without limitation liability for any travel related to the Contest, death, personal injury, loss, and/or disability; (b) under no circumstances will participant be permitted to obtain awards for, and participant hereby waives all rights to claim, punitive, incidental, consequential, or any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses; (c) all causes of action arising out of or connected with this Contest, or any prize awarded, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action; and (d) any and all claims, judgments, and award shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, excluding attorneys' fees and court costs. You agree to execute and deliver documents to us that we may request to confirm our rights under these Official Rules.
20. **MISCELLANEOUS:** Winner(s) must submit proof of eligibility and may be required to sign the Sponsor's Affidavit to claim the prize. The Sponsor may substitute prizes, as well as extend, modify, or discontinue the Contest at any time without prior notice. The Sponsor disclaims any responsibility to notify participants of any aspect related to the conduct of the Contest. The Contest Entities are not responsible for any typographical error in the printing of these Official Rules, administration of the Contest or in the announcement of the Contest prizes.
21. **WINNER LIST:** To view the Grand Prize and Runner-Up winners' video entries, visit the Radio Show's website by August 28, 2010.
22. **JURISDICTION:** By entering, participants agree that all issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, participant's rights and obligations, or the rights and obligations of the Sponsor in connection with the Contest, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of State of Texas without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules. By entering, participants consent to the jurisdiction and venue of the federal, state, and local courts located in Bexar County, Texas.
